

Repatriation/Transfer of Mortal Remains/Ashes

**Application can be made by sending scanned copies of required documents
(In English or French only) by email to the Mauritius Embassy in Geneva**

The following documents should invariably be submitted along with request for repatriation of mortal remains/ashes:

- (i) Death Certificate specifying the cause of death;
- (ii) Embalming certificate/certificat d'embaumement;
- (iii) Birth Certificate, Passport/Identity Card (Certificate if identity of the deceased)

2. Where Death Certificate could not be obtained with reasonable time, a document signed by a Medical Practitioner specifying the cause of death of the person should be provided in lieu of Death Certificate.

3. The cause of death of the deceased is a crucial information before the Ministry of Health & QoL, Mauritius can issue a “No objection” to the landing of the mortal remains in Mauritius.

All required documents should be in English or French only.
