Repatriation/Transfer of Mortal Remains/Ashes

Application can be made by sending scanned copies of required documents (In English or French only) by email to the Mauritius Embassy in Geneva

The following documents should invariably be submitted along with request for repatriation of mortal remains/ashes:

- (i) Death Certificate specifying the cause of death;
- (ii) Embalming certificate/certificat d'embaumement;
- (iii) Birth Certificate, Passport/Identity Card (Certificate if identity of the deceased)
- 2. Where Death Certificate could not be obtained with reasonable time, a document signed by a Medical Practitioner specifying the cause of death of the person should be provided in lieu of Death Certificate.
- 3. The cause of death of the deceased is a crucial information before the Ministry of Health & QoL, Mauritius can issue a "No objection" to the landing of the mortal remains in Mauritius.

All required documents should be in English or French only.
